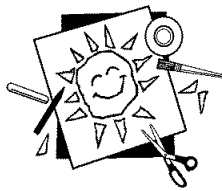
From Your Board Of Properties

Our preschool year has almost ended; our last day of school will be on Thursday, May 23rd. We will have a short graduation program in the Parish Hall at 10:30 am, with refreshments following afterwards.

We are now taking registrations for 2019/2020 preschool year! We accept children 3-5 years old (must be potty trained). To register you may contact Rita in the church office. There is a short form to fill out and a \$25.00 registration fee to hold a child's place in the class. Once we are full, we do start a waiting list. It always seems as if we end up having a couple of spots open up towards the end of the summer-beginning of the school year.

For preschool attendance in the fall we do require all immunizations to be up to date/in the process of updating/or a exemption form completed by physician and ready to turn in at our preschool open house. A Washington State Certificate of Immunization Status will be sent home in the preschool packet of papers in late August to be completed (some pediatricians will print out the Washington State Form for you).

Thank you to all the parents who have ordered books during the year. For every book ordered, we receive points that preschool has used to add books to our library! We have a fantastic library of books that the students check out to take home because of the help of this Scholastic program. Since we started the library book check out several years ago, it has been a big success. Reading at this young age is so important for continued success, so keep up the reading over the summer! Go to our public libraries, they offer great summer reading programs for children of all ages.

We consider it a privilege to teach your children. They touch our lives in such a wonderful way, bringing us joy and laughter. However, our biggest accomplishment is to know that each child leaves our class knowing that Jesus loves them. Thank you for trusting us with your children.
