Volunteer Opportunities at Centralia Hospital

Perhaps you've also heard of the shortage of hospital staff and the pressures they are under to meet the needs of their patients. Did you know there were opportunities for volunteering at our local hospital where you can make a difference in the patient's experience with your acts of kindness and helping hands?

The COVID pandemic basically did away with the volunteer program at Centralia Hospital. But with the slowing of the spread of the illness, volunteer opportunities are also beginning to be open to those who wish to offer a helping hand. Examples of where you can help include:

- Patient Rounders & Unit Support
- Paw-Assisted Wellness Services (PAWS)
- No One Dies Alone (NODA) and No One Alone (NOA)
- Information & Admitting Desk
- Pharmacy Support
- Rehab/Therapy Mobility Support
- Emergency Department
- Administrative/Office
- Infusion Center Support (Regional Cancer Systems only, located in Lacey, Centralia, and Aberdeen

Most positions require a commitment of 75 hours of service. This usually takes six months volunteering once a week for a three-to-four-hour shift. Exceptions to this requirement are PAWS, NODA, and the Patient Advisory Council – these programs have their own unique set of requirements. To pursue a volunteer position, candidates will need to complete the rather extensive list of steps. Considering you will be involved with the health and welfare of another human being, it is really not asking too much. Please be aware that the entire onboarding process may take several weeks. Before applying to be a Providence volunteer, applicants are encouraged to contact Volunteer Services to learn more about position availability, locations. responsibilities, and required commitments.
